## Eligibility

The competition is open to all.

All skiers must hold a valid racing license issued by NC. If not, a Supporting Member Day License (SMDL) needs to be purchased during the online registration process.

All Québec skiers must also have a SFQ license or buy a SFQ Day License online for each race day.

**NOTE THAT NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE FOR ANY DAY LICENSES (NC or SFQ) NOT REQUIRED BUT PURCHASED BY MISTAKE.**

Racing up is allowed at registration online but racers may race up by only one age-category. The athlete who will race up must select the minimum year of birth of the new category when registering online.

## Restrictions on Equipment

Only the Swenor 65-000 of the NC and Fondeurs Laurentides fleet and the Rundle Velox from Cross Country Ski Ontario wheeled skis with wheels # 2 will be allowed. Please indicate in the registration form the type of bindings you use. Skis will be assigned randomly in accordance with CCR396.2.11. Poles shall comply with RCC 343.8.1 and 396.2.5 for free technique races. A safety helmet (e.g. DIN EN 1078 or equivalent) and protective goggles must be worn per CCR396.2.7.

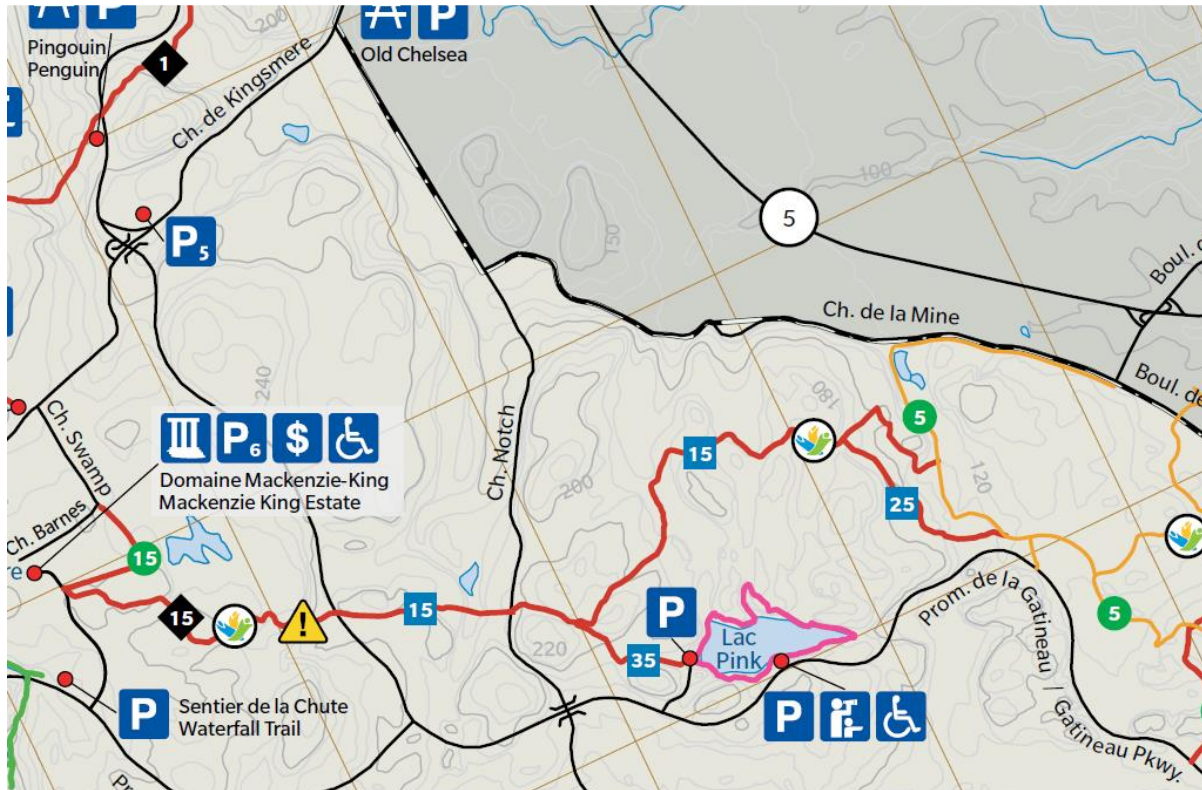
The deadline for registration is 19 September, 2019, at 23:59.

The course will be on a portion of the Gatineau Parkway between Penguin and trail #15.

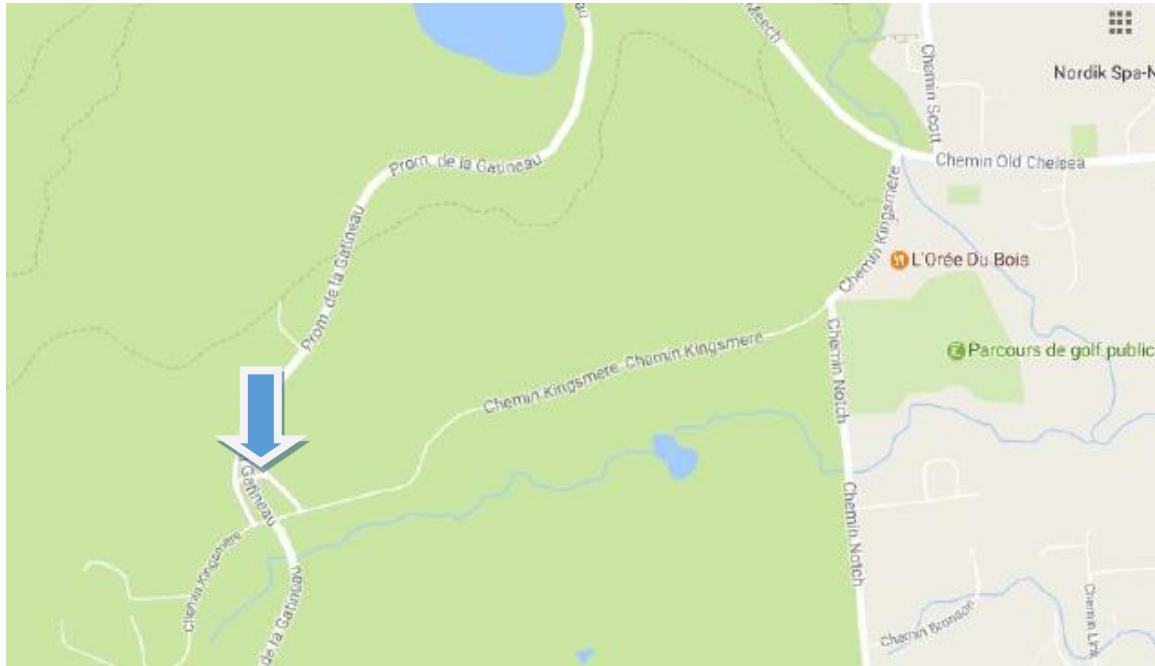


## Safety while on course

### **Timing**

### **Seeding**

A chevron start will be used, with athletes placed on the chevron according to CPL. Only double poling is permitted on the first 50 meters of the course in accordance with CCR396.8.1.2. Distance CPL ending 16 April 2019 will be used.

Skiers with a NC license and without points will have their starting order randomly drawn in the same group and will start behind the seeded group. Skiers of those categories without a NC license will have their starting order randomly drawn in the same group and will start behind the NC license holders group.

The start list will be posted on zone4.ca on 20 September, 2019, at 7 p.m. No changes will be possible after that time.

### **Bib distribution**

Starting at 6:30 a.m.

Club with racers who do not return their bib at the end of each race will be charged \$30 CAD for their replacement.

Bibs will be collected in the finish corral.

### **Skis Distribution**

The skis will be distributed 15 minutes before the start to allow skiers time to become familiar with the skis and ensure proper function.

Skiers must use their own skis to warm up before going to the start area.

Skis will be retrieved in the finish corral. Club with racers who do not return their skis at the end of each race will be charged \$350 CAD for their replacement
